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Dr. Partha Haldar, a dynamic and dedicated professional, is an alumnus of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, (AIIMS) at New Delhi, India. He is also an alumna of Indian Institute of Management, Bengaluru, India (IIM-B), and of Erasmus Medical Centre, Rotterdam, Netherlands. He is currently serving as a Faculty Member at the AIIMS New Delhi since 2014. His journey reflects a promising career in public health, marked by sincere and diligent contributions to academia and research, evident by his numerous publications, research work, and mentorship of numerous MD and PhD students. In this role, Dr. Partha Haldar has advised numerous MD students, masters, and doctoral students as a Guide, mentor, co-supervisor, and dissertation committee member. He has undertaken over 30 research projects, showcasing his proactive approach to research and program implementation. His commitment is evident in close to 100 publications in peer-reviewed indexed journals, highlighting his significant contributions to advancing medical knowledge.

With extensive programmatic experience gained as an Epidemiologist with the World Health Organization at the India office, and at the regional office for South East Asia, Dr. Haldar continues to provide technical assistance to national programs under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. As a member of various technical advisory groups at the Ministry, he actively contributes to shaping healthcare policies, including areas like surveillance for Viral Hepatitis, Laboratory Services for Viral Hepatitis, Health Care for Transgender People, and HIV Self-testing.

Dr. Haldar is a guest lecturer at prestigious management institutes of the country, bringing a unique blend of medical and management expertise to the academic sphere. His dynamic

approach extends to conducting workshops on systematic reviews and meta-analysis, reflecting his commitment to fostering research methodologies and academic excellence.

Summary of academic interests

Dr. Partha Haldar emerges as a multifaceted researcher with a diverse portfolio of strengths and interests in the realm of public health and medical research. His ongoing large-scale implementation studies, particularly the uniform stroke care pathway initiative and the quality-assured emergency care services project, underscore his commitment to translating research into impactful healthcare practices. With a robust foundation in genetic epidemiology, his collaborations with mentors from Erasmus Medical Centre, Rotterdam, and faculty members from Harvard TS Chan School of Public Health reflect his dedication to fostering credible partnerships on a global scale.

Dr. Partha Haldar's foray into psychiatric epidemiology and sleep-cognition studies, coupled with the burgeoning collaboration in suicidal research, demonstrates a keen interest in addressing critical health challenges with a holistic approach. His special focus on evidence-based medicine, evident through numerous systematic reviews and meta-analyses, establishes him as a leader in this field. Moreover, his role as a mentor and collaborator across various medical disciplines showcases his commitment to fostering a collaborative and supportive research environment.

Academic Interest Areas:

Dr. Partha Haldar's research interests include implementation research, genetic epidemiology, sleep-cognition, psychiatric epidemiology, alternative medicine and systematic reviews/meta-analysis.

Currently, he is doing a large-scale *implementation study* along with Department of Neurology in implementing a uniform stroke care pathway at 22 medical colleges in India. This study, funded by Department of Health Research, Government of India, is based on a hybrid-3 design, protocol is available here: (<u>https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/36211192/</u>) and the baseline findings are in International Journal of Stroke here: (<u>https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/37577976/</u>). The findings were also presented in World Stroke Conference 2023 at Canada, and European Stroke Congress (2024). He is presently also involved in another implementation study aiming to implement a quality assured emergency care services in India.

Additionally, he is actively engaged in the field of *genetic epidemiology*, GWAS, EWAS, and PGRS analyses. The journey started with God's grace after accomplishing MS in Genetic and Molecular Epidemiology from Erasmus Medical Centre, Rotterdam at the Netherlands. This is a still a nascent stage in his career, where he is actively working with his mentors from EMC, Rotterdam, and looking forward to have a credible collaboration. He is very much open to collaborate on this front.

The work on *psychiatric-epidemiology, and sleep-cognitions* are a related front wherein he is working with faculty members from Harvard TS Chan School of Public Health at Baltimore, MS, USA. Based on their India Cohort of adult populations aged 50 and above, he has published two

papers so far on this dataset; one describes the independent role of psychiatric and metabolic factors in causing obstructive sleep apnea and poor sleep quality published here: (<u>https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/36280653/</u>), and another one describing the association of poor sleep quality and obstructive sleep apnea with cognition measures in this age-group, published here: (<u>https://pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/38055152/</u>). Presently, he is working to explore the relation of dietary factors with cognition. A budding and extremely exciting collaboration in this regard is in suicidal research with Department of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology at AIIMS New Delhi, and University of Utah, USA.

One of his special interests is in *evidence-based medicine*, and in this aspect, he has extensive publications (26 till date) of systematic reviews and meta-analyses, and one each of scoping review and umbrella review. He is a mentor and supportive friend to many a colleague in the Institute for evidence-based medicine. In addition, colleagues from departments of pain, anesthesia, geriatrics, biophysics, medical oncology, pediatric oncology, neurology, collaborate with him for which he has earmarked some time dedicatedly.

The *association with prestigious management Institutes* in the country is explored as and when requests come from them for guest lectures. These are mainly in the new and upcoming frontiers in healthcare innovation, decision sciences, and design thinking.

An open invitation for collaboration echoes throughout Dr. Partha Haldar's journey.
