- From June 2011 to May 2013 I worked as Consultant in Dept of Anesthesiology, sub-specialty Neuroanesthesiology, at King Fahd Medical City Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. This is a prestigious tertiary care hospital catering to the complex neurosurgical (cranial as well as spine) patients referred to it from various parts of Saudi Arabia. This hospital has state of the art facilities (including Brain Suite) to manage various cranial and spinal cases. It has five ORs catering to cranial and complex spinal cases. There I was involved in teaching of Neuroanaesthesia subject to anaesthesia Resident trainees who came to this hospital (for Neuroanesthesia training) from various other hospitals of the country.

Experience / Skills Gained

I have experience of managing all kinds of surgical patients independently. At my neurosciences centre, (AIIMS New Delhi, India) approximately **3000 patients** of all age groups are operated annually. In addition, about 600 patients undergo neuroradiological interventional procedures under anaesthesia.

In the initial phase of my career as lecturer and senior resident (Registrar), I worked in all the surgical specialities (general surgery, orthopaedics, urology, ENT, Ophthalmology, obstetrics and gynae, trauma) and superspecialities of paediatric surgery, cardiovascular & thoracic surgery & neurosurgery. Profile of patients managed included Exploratory laparotomies, Leino-renal shunts, oncological surgery, TURP, Cystectomy, Renal transplant, Phaechromocytoma, Tracheal repair for stenosis, laryngectomy, excision of Nasopharyngeal tumours, Microlaryngeal surgery, Wertheim's hysterectomy, simple hysterectomy, Vulvectomy, Vaginal reconstruction, Caesarian section, Harrington rod insertion, open reduction and internal fixation of fractures, hand surgery, amputation, Tracheo oesophageal fistula repair, repair of Diaphragmatic hernia, colonic pull through, Retinal surgery, squint repair, etc.
