Health Minister Shri J.P.Nadda chairs the 154th meeting of the Governing Body and 150th Meeting of the Institute Body of AIIMS

Health Minister Shri J.P.Nadda chaired the 154th meeting of the Governing Body and 150th Meeting of the Institute Body of AIIMS on October 21, 2016 at Nirman Bhavan New Delhi.

The Institute Body was informed by AIIMS administration that the vacancy circular for the post of Director AIIMS was issued on October 1, 2016 and the last date of applications is November 15, 2016. To ensure timely filling up of the emergent vacancy the Institute Body authorized the President AIIMS to constitute the search cum selection committee to the post of Director AIIMS which falls vacant on January 31, 2017 on similar lines as in the case of 2013 recruitment.

The Governing Body approved the recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee for recruitment against 118 vacant posts of Assistant Professors in AIIMS. The Governing Body also approved the proposals of the Standing Selection Committee for promotion of 81 Additional Professors to the rank of Professors under the accelerated promotion scheme.

The Governing Body reviewed the progress of the ongoing civil works of AIIMS under the National Cancer Institute. Shri J.P.Nadda, Health Minister and President AIIMS directed that the AIIMS administration take all steps necessary to operationalise the National Cancer Institute by April 2018. Shri Nadda also directed that the works on the redevelopment of AIIMS residential colonies for construction of 3928 residential apartments with an allocation of Rs.4441 crores as approved by the Union Cabinet may be expeditiously commenced.

The Governing Body reviewed the progress of the AIIMS Transformation Project being executed as a CSR project in collaboration between AIIMS-TCS and expressed satisfaction with the progress achieved in Phase I of the project which has benefitted over 35 lac patients with a patient friendly experience.

The Governing Body appreciated the efforts of AIIMS for building an international collaboration with French Academy of Medicine in Cardiology, Oncology and Infectious Diseases and noted that a 11 member AIIMS delegation would be visiting Paris and Toulouse for the 2 day International Conference in November 2016.
