

The National Poisons Information Centre (NPIC) conducts specialized training and observership programs for Poison Information Officers to enhance competency in clinical toxicology and poison management. These programs provide hands-on exposure to poison information services, toxicology databases, emergency response systems, case documentation, toxicovigilance, and risk assessment. Trainees gain practical experience in handling poisoning-related queries, interpretation of toxicological data, and evidence-based management strategies. The programs also promote skill development in communication, poison prevention, and analytical toxicology, thereby strengthening national poison information and emergency response services.
