- Presentation by Mr. Pankaj Kumar, Chief MSWO, to nursing staff on interdepartmental coordination for better patient care.



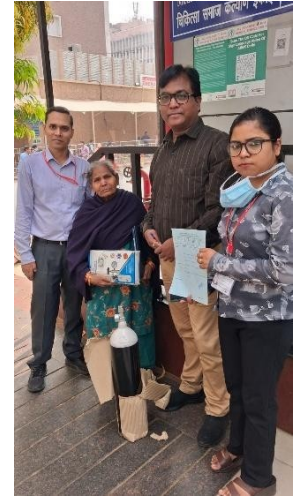
