1. **DIRECTOR** of **A.I.I.M.S. HOSPITAL** is hereby granted an authorization to operate a facility for generation, collection and storage of biomedical waste at the premises of **Ansari Nagar East New Delhi - 110016** and for transport, treatment and disposal of bio-medical waste through any of the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) in Delhi authorized by Delhi Pollution Control Committee.
2. This authorization shall be in force for a period of **3 Years** from the date of application and shall be valid up to **18-03-2017**
3. This authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and to such other conditions as may be specified in the Rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Terms and conditions of authorization

1. The occupier shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
2. The occupier shall comply with the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998, as amended to date.
3. Effluent Treatment Plant(ETP) installed, shall be properly operated and maintained and the treated effluent shall be recycled / reused in horticulture, air conditioning / cooling plants and in flushing of toilet etc. The occupier will comply with the standards prescribed in Schedule V of BMW Rules, for the discharge of the Waste Water / Effluent generated from the hospital and submit the Effluent Analysis Report, both for inlet (untreated) & outlet (treated) effluent of ETP for the parameters prescribed for liquid waste in Schedule V of said BMW Rules from any of the Empanelled Laboratories of Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) on quarterly basis to DPCC.
4. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by DPCC.
5. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the bio-medical waste without obtaining prior permission of DPCC.
6. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipments or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.
7. It shall be ensured that the Bio Medical Waste is finally treated within a period of 48 hours. If for any reason it becomes unavoidable, intimation should be given in writing to DPCC and measures are to be ensured so that the waste does not adversely affect human health and the environment.
8. It is the duty of the authorized person to intimate DPCC immediately in case of closure of the facility/unit.
9. The occupier shall have a valid agreement with the operator of a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) authorized by DPCC for collection, transportation, treatment & disposal of the bio-medical

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
