Prof. Rajinder Parshad was present in Surgery Block but did not attend as on previous occasions.

## Agenda and discussion

Prof. Sunil Chumber, Head, welcomed all faculty members present in the meeting, and the following agenda were discussed.

- MCh Transplant Surgery He proposed to convert the existing Renal Transplant
   Fellowship programme to MCh Renal Transplant, and requested Prof. V. K. Bansal to
   undertake necessary steps to initiate the programme. This was unanimously agreed
   upon.
- 2. Fellowship in Colorectal Surgery He emphasized the need and feasibility of a Fellowship in Colorectal Surgery, and requested Prof. H.K. Bhattacharjee to prepare

the curriculum and to undertake necessary steps to initiate the programme, which was unanimously agreed upon.

- 3. MCh Thoracic Surgery He proposed the initiation of an MCh course in Thoracic Surgery. Since Dr. Rajinder Parshad is not cooperating, Dr. Mohit was entrusted with this task.
- 4. Thesis guide He stated the revised guidelines for allotment of thesis guide. Dr Bansal stated that these were only guidelines and not rules, and the final decision of thesis allotment will be taken by the department. He informed that Dr. Kamal Kataria and Dr. Devender Singh are allocating the residents according to a roster.
- 5. He stated that at present there are only 72 residents, and there is provision for another 24 residents. These seats are currently not being filled. With increase in number of units, operating rooms and consequent patient turnover, there is a need for increasing the number of residents.
- 6. He stated that the OPD is extremely crowded, making it difficult even for doctors to move into and out of their rooms. There is a need for more space in the OPD. At least another 15 to 20 rooms are needed, along with a waiting area for patients. A meeting with the Director is being planned in this regard.
- 7. Prof. Sunil Chumber stated that it is desirable that the OT roster should be made such that each unit has 3 OT days, one day for OPD, one day for grand round, and one day in a week for class and research. OT distribution should be equitable in the unit.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks.
