ITEM NO. SFC - 214/1

CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF 213TH MEETING OF THE STANDING FINANCE COMMITTEE OF AIIMS HELD ON 14TH SEPTEMBER, 2016 IN MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE, NIRMAN BHAWAN, NEW DELHI

The SFC confirmed the minutes of the meeting and no amendments were proposed by any of the members.

TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL FOR REVISED ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR 2016-17 AND THE BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR 2017-18 UNDER PLAN, NON-PLAN AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The SFC considered the proposals and agreed for the following:

- (a) Revised Estimates 2016-17 as per actuals approved by Parliament in the Supplementary Demands for Grants;
- (b) Chairman advised that the Institute should as far as possible make realistic projection for salaries and related expenditure in order to avoid major enhancement of demands at RE stage.
- (c) The Institute apprised SFC about limitation of funds under Oversight head. Chairman directed AIIMS to submit details of pending liabilities and also to what extent they can be taken under Plan in 2017-18.

ITEM NO. SFC - 214/3

PROGRESS OF ENGINEERING WORKS

The SFC considered the progress of engineering works. The progress of works was found to be satisfactory. The SFC agreed that the proposal for PMC charges of HSCC for the CIMR Block shall be 5 percent of the cost of civil works given the small size of work.

ITEM NO. SFC - 214/4

TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL FOR THE SELECTION OF PMC FOR MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT PROCUREMENT OF NCI JHAJJAR

The SFC considered the proposal for selection of PMC for Machinery and Equipment procurement for NCI Jhajjar. A presentation was made by Head National Cancer Institute on the efforts made to ensure timely completion of M&E procurement of NCI Jhajjar. The Deputy Director Administration said that M/s HITES presented a dedicated team of officials for the M&E procurement, had greater experience of in procurement of Cancer equipment as was decidedly superior in qualitative terms to M/s HSCC. SFC agreed with the proposal to change the PMC for Machinery & Equipments from HSCC to HLL/HITES, subject to the condition that HSCC was not specifically approved by the Cabinet for this purpose. The Cabinet Note may be examined in the Ministry.

The SFC recommended procurement of the 1.5 T MRI scanner at a cost of Rs. 11.81 crores from the L-I bidder M/s Seimens.

The SFC accorded in-principle recommendation for the procurement of Rs. 31.38 crores for M&E of Surgical Block subject to detailed examination by the Procurement Division/ Internal Finance Division/ Administrative Authority of the Institute.

TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL FOR THE APPROVAL FOR GAIT LAB INSTALLATION AT THE DEPARTMENT OF ORTHOPAEDICS

The SFC recommended the proposal for purchase and installation of a Gait Lab in the Department of Orthopedics at a cost of Rs. 5 crores to modernize the department with latest technology for movement disorders like cerebral palsy, spinal deformity and complex joint replacement.
