This program is in series of modules targeted towards Pediatricians predominantly practicing Pediatric Pulmonology and Intensive Care.

Course contents: Updates on organ dysfunction and management in the PICU. Will include pediatric ARDS (challenges and current practices), non-invasive ventilation (basics and initiation), resuscitation and de-resuscitation in septic shock, advanced hemodynamic monitoring in refractory shock, acute myocarditis (advances in management), liver, renal and nutritional support, neurocritical illness (refractory status, raised ICP), and hyperferritinemia in the ICU, point-of-care imaging among others.
