We are pleased to invite you to participate in the **“Rencontres Universitaires Et Scientifiques De Haut Niveau (RUSH)/High-Level Academic and Scientific Meetings”** being held on **February 18th and 19th, 2026** at All India Institute of Medical Science (AIIMS), New Delhi, India, coordinated by the French Embassy (please find attached the registration information in page 2).

I am pleased to invite you to the **"High-Level University and Scientific Meetings on the Future of Indo-French Cooperation"** (French acronym: **RUSH**) to be held in New Delhi on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> February 2026 on the sidelines of the AI Impact Summit.

These Meetings will be held during the visit of the **President of the French Republic**, Mr Emmanuel Macron, to India to participate in the AI Impact Summit, inaugurate the India-France Year of Innovation, and more broadly strengthen our strategic partnership with India, in which academic and scientific cooperation is set to play an increasingly important role.

With more than 100 French and Indian institutions expected to attend, these meetings are set to be the **largest Indo-French scientific and academic** event of its kind ever organised. On 18<sup>th</sup> February, after a half-day dedicated to the 28<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the strategic partnership between France and India, RUSH will welcome the President of the French Republic. On 19<sup>th</sup> February, one half of the day will be devoted to AI, while the other will focus on scientific exchanges on brain diseases, with parallel networking meetings between French and Indian institutions. Various initiatives will be launched on this occasion, such as the inauguration of a **Franco-Indian Centre for Research in AI for Health**.

These Meetings, which will enable you to meet your counterparts – presidents of French universities – will be an opportunity to consider new partnerships and give your international development strategies a significant boost through the dynamic Indo-French relationship, which will reach a new milestone during the presidential visit.
