IACAM



The association organizes biennial national conference and mid-term Continuing Medical Education (CME) program, promoting continuous professional development. A significant milestone was its affiliation with the International Association for Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Allied Professions (IACAPAP) in July 1994, which facilitated international collaboration. In 2005, IACAM launched a journal to share research insights, further enriching the field. In 2023, it partnered with UNICEF's Regional Office for South Asia to create the Child and Adolescent Mental Health South Asia Regional Network (CAMHSAN), demonstrating its commitment to regional advocacy. Additionally, the IACAM Academy offers a ten-month capacity-building program, emphasizing education and research dissemination through public lectures and workshops.
