NOTICE OF DEBARMENT/BLACKLISTING

Subject: GEM Contract No. GEMC-511687730072939 in favor of M/s K.S Entire Group for procurement of Stitched Patient Kurta & Pyjama to AIIMS, New Delhi - termination of contract and debarment/ blacklisted for two years from participating in tenders thereof.

Whereas:

1. AIIMS, New Delhi, placed a GeM contract vide no. GEMC-511687730072939 on GeM Portal dated 25.09.2025 against GeM Bid No.GEM/2025/B/6053074 with M/s K.S. Entire Group for Stitched Patient Kurta & Pyjama for various user department of AIIMS.
2. Upon the usage of the material supplied, it was observed that the firm has supplied the inferior/substandard quality of the Patients Kurta & Pyjamas in the 2nd Lot, delivered on 20.11.2025 & 15.12.2025 against Challan No. 250 & 255 respectively.
3. As per directions of competent authority, a Show Cause Notice dated 20.01.2026 was served upon M/s K. S. Entire Group to replace the substandard material within 7 days as well as explanation was called as to why administrative action should not be initiated against the vendor for supply of substandard material.

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4. Vide the said Show cause Notice, it was clearly communicated to submit reply within three working days and replacement of substandard material within seven days from the date of issue of the Notice and in case of failure to provide a satisfactory explanation within the stipulated time, appropriate administrative action shall be initiated including termination of the contract and forfeiture of PBG submitted by the firm.
5. Samples from the supplied Patient Kurta & Pyjama were also sent to the Laboratory authorized under Ministry of Textiles for the evaluation of contract parameters. Whereas, the laboratory evaluation of the Patient Kurta & Pyjama supplied by the firm revealed major deviations with respect to the prescribed contract parameters. The findings indicate non-conformity of the supplied material to the approved specifications, thereby constituting a breach of the contractual on the part of the firm. **Copy of test report attached as Annexure I.**
6. The firm did not replied in response to the above show-cause notice, was deemed unsatisfactory by the competent authority.
7. As per directions of competent authority, a reminder of Show Cause Notice dated 27.01.2026 was served upon M/s K. S. Entire Group for explanation within two days, failing which it was assumed that the firm has nothing to state in this matter.
8. The reply of the firm vide letter dated 29.01.2026 intimating that they have mistakenly sent the material of other hospital to the AIIMS, New Delhi. Further they committed to replace the substandard material within one month but the firm failed to fulfill the commitment till date.
9. The firm was intimated about the intimation of risk purchase clause vide letter dated 29.01.2026
10. Before recommending any administrative action, competent authority constituted a committee for personal hearing to provide the M/s K. S. Entire Group final opportunity to submit his explanation/representation against the proposed administrative action.
11. The personal hearing committee in the meeting held on dated 25.02.2026, observed that the firm had not adequately responded with detailed supporting documents when given the opportunity to do so in response to the show cause notices issued on 27.01.2026 & 29.01.2026. The committee deliberated upon the submission made by the firm and examined the facts of the case in detail. It was observed that the firm failed to respond to the show cause notice within the stipulated time and that the explanation furnished was not satisfactory. The representative of the firm committed to replace the substandard material within 10 days.

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12. In light of these findings, the personal hearing committee concluded that the supply of substandard material by an established vendor reflects poor adherence to corrective action was also viewed seriously.
13. Despite the commitment made before the Hearing Committee, the firm has failed to replace the substandard material till date.
14. After due consideration, the Committee concluded that action for initiation of debarment proceedings against the firm shall be taken as per application rules and contract conditions including:
 - (1) Termination of the existing contract due to persistent breaches of the contractual obligations.
 - (2) Forfeit the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) submitted by the Firm.
 - (3) Debarment of M/s K. S. Entire Group from participating in AIIMS tenders and contracts for 02 years.
15. GeM General Terms and Conditions on GeM 4.0 (Version 1.25) dt 14th July 2025, vide point no. 19., Termination for Default (Page no. 34): If the seller does not perform its obligations within the Delivery Period / Date mentioned in the Contract, the same would constitute the breach of the Contract and the Buyer shall have the right to Cancel or Withdraw the Contract for the unsupplied portion after the expiry of the original, extended or re-fixed delivery date or period stipulated in the Contract. Such cancellation of contract on account of non - performance by the Seller would entitle the Buyer to forfeit the performance security besides other actions such as downgrading the Seller's rating or debarment from the GeM for specified period as decided by GeM on merits.
16. As per GeM General Terms and Conditions on GeM 4.0 (Version 1.25)dt 14th July 2025, vide point no. 21. Grounds for Administrative Action
 - ii) *The Seller would be liable for administrative actions such as suspension / debarment/ removal from GeM, if they fail to abide by any of the Website Policies including the terms & conditions stipulated in this document and/or on anyone or more of the following grounds:*
 - (c) *Supplies goods of inferior/ substandard quality*
 - (j) *Fails to execute an order/ contract or fail to execute it satisfactorily*
 - iv) *GeM may take an administrative action in terms of the GeM Website Policies against a Buyer which may include reporting of any breach or misconduct to the Buyer Primary User and/or to the competent authority and GeM reserves the right to review the rating of such Buyer, and / or block Buyer's account for such time as considered appropriate by GeM.*
17. The violations of contractual obligations by M/s K. S. Entire Group lead to the competent authority at AIIMS, New Delhi to view these matters with utmost seriousness and decided to debar M/s K. S. Entire Group under the provisions of

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Clause 5 (C) of O.M. F.1/20/2018-PPD dated 02.11.2021 issued by Procurement Policy Division, Deptt. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India. Now therefore, in view of the Committee(s) recommendations and persistent breaches of the contractual obligations, blatant disregard of ethical business practices, the competent authority at AIIMS has left with no other option but to terminate the contract with M/s K. S. Entire Group and as per provisions of the contract directed to invoke Clause 19 (Termination for Default) of General Terms & Conditions of GeM Contract.

18. The competent authority has therefore decided to initiate the following actions with immediate effect from the issue of this order:
- (a) The contract no. GEM Contract No. GEMC-511687730072939 dated 25.09.2025 stands terminated with immediate effect.
 - (b) The Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) submitted by M/s K. S. Entire Group in the form of FDR No. 21038242 for an amount of Rs. 83,760.00 issued by ICICI Bank Ltd. valid up to 26.04.2027 submitted against this contract stands forfeited.
 - (c) An incident to be raised on the GeM Portal against K. S. Entire Group.
 - (d) The firm K. S. Entire Group stands debarred for 02 years from participating in AIIMS tenders with immediate effect.
