TENDER CORRIGENDUM

The Tender No. 90/CNC/NS/2025-26/st. with Tender ID: 2025_AIMSD_884486_1 was published in CPP Portal (e-Procurement) on 06.11.2025 for the purchase of "Microsurgical Instruments for Microvascular Surgery for Neurosurgery (Bipolar Forceps)" for the department of Neurosurgery, CNC, AIIMS. The pre-bid meeting was held on 19.11.2025 wherein only single bidder (M/s.Overseas Associates) has attended the meeting and discussed their issues before the TSEC. Upon the request of potential vendors & recommendation of user department the following amendment has been carried in the bid submission end date, opening date and specification of said tender as under:-

REVISED TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

Sr. No.	Item: Microsurgical Instruments for Microvascular Surgery for Neurosurgery (Bipolar Forceps) Qty: As per Specification
1.	Company should have USFDA certificate / CE certificates with 4 digit notifying body, identification number of international standards / BIS certification.
2.	Company name and catalogue / article number engraved on each instrument.
3.	Each instrument should have data matrix/bar code.
4.	Corrosion free, high surgical grade stainless steel (Stainless steel alloy of 400-450 grade).
5.	Physical demonstrations of all instruments shall be mandatory by the bidders called for technical evaluation after fulfilling the pre qualification criteria.
6.	The bidder must enclose original literature and technical data sheet in support of the technical bid.
7.	Material certificate from the original manufacturer should be attached along with technical bid.
8.	The bidders should quote as per the specification attached with not more than $\pm 5\%$ variation in the sizes of the instruments.
9.	Warranty of 3 years to be provided for quoted instruments.
10.	Physical demonstration of all the instruments is mandatory. The parameters for demonstration will be certificate of quality (by certified body recognised by Govt of India), sharpness, joint function, reflection, tissue holding property, visible manufacturer's mark, Passivation quality, esthetic feel during use, gap between holding jaws.
11.	*Catalogue number and company where mentioned is only for ease of visual identification by the bidders. It should not be understood as being specific to a manufacturer.
12.	Non-stick, silver or gold tips with insulation extending upto the tip
13.	Light weight
14.	Cords, accessories etc. to be provided so that it can be connected to existing bipolar generator machines in NS OT

1.	In no case the instrument should remain in non-working condition for more than 7 days, beyond which a penalty as per the rules of the institute will be levied.
2.	The vendor should have a good service and application back up along with instruments to provide an effective trouble shooting and support. (Response time <24 hours).
3.	All technical bids comparative statement to the tender specifications must be enclosed along with reference no., paragraph no. From original catalogue of the equipment.
4.	Original Manufacturer or their subsidiary or authorized dealer who is quoting should be present in India having selling experience of more than 05 years with at least 5 installations in government institutes/hospitals.
5.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The bidder supplying indigenous goods or imported goods shall quote only in Indian Rupees (INR). Bids, where prices are quoted in any other way shall be treated as non -responsive and rejected. Price quoted in foreign currency will not be considered and bid will be summarily rejected, therefore quote must be in INR only.
6.	CAMC will not be applicable on this tender being instrument nature of item. CAMC clause mentioned in this bid documents may be treated null and void.
7.	If any instrument is found to be defective, misshaped, or not functioning properly during the warranty period, it shall be replaced with a new instrument promptly, without any delay or additional charges.

Bidders must consider &upload the following documents in the Technical bid & price bid.

1. Tender acceptance Form (as per bid format)
2. Manufacturers Authorization Certificate (As per bid format)
3. Country of origin of quoted product.
4. Product brochure
5. Technical bid (with Make, Model and detailed scope of supply)

7. Product Certifications.
8. Complete terms & conditions (Including warranty, bank details, mode of shipment, taxes, etc.)
9. Product HSN Code& Sellers GeM ID number must be mentioned in the technical bid.
10. Details of Service Centre, (Complete Address)
11. Undertaking of Fall Clause, No Case pending in CBI/Vigilance, Non-blacklist in AIIMS, New Delhi or any other Govt./reputed Pvt. Hospitals/Organizations.
12. Restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of the GFRs 2017 as per order no. F.No.6/18/2019 PPD dated 23rd July, 2020 regarding sharing issued by Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division will be applicable. Relevant documents regarding this order to be uploaded (if applicable).
13. Bidders Registration Certificate, GST certificate, drug license, CDSCO certificate (if applicable).

14. Financial bids should be in the format provided in the CPP portal and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders.
15. Price bid (with complete scope of supply, price break-up of all items), complete list of quoted product must be uploaded in pdf at financial bid (space given in the CPP Portal).

All remaining terms & conditions of floated bid will remain same. The bidder must see the above amendment and quote their product accordingly. In this regard, revised BoQ has also uploaded.
