Subject: Withdrawal of offer after bid finalization in GeM Bid No. GEM/2025/B/6481559 for procurement of Povidone Iodine 10% Solution – 500 ml –Notice of debarment thereof.

Sir,

AIIMS, New Delhi had floated GeM Bid No. GEM/2025/B/6481559 for procurement of Povidone Iodine 10% Solution – 500 ml for Institute use. After completion of the Reverse Auction, M/s Vinayak Manutrade Private Limited emerged as L-1 bidder, having quoted a rate of ₹39/- per bottle. However, immediately after price finalization and declaration as L-1, your firm communicated through email stating as under:


“We have not supply Povidone Iodine 10% Solution – 500 ml. We have mistakenly quoted the rate in the tender, therefore kindly cancel this order.”

Thus, your firm withdrew its offer after bid finalization, despite having participated in the bid and reverse auction process with full knowledge of specifications and quantities.

Whereas, the matter was placed before the Competent Authority and administrative action was proposed. After approval, the following actions were taken:

1. An incident was raised on the GeM portal against your firm.
2. A letter was issued to the Ministry of MSME, as your firm had availed MSME benefits and was exempted from EMD submission.
3. A Show Cause Notice dated 19.11.2025 was issued to your firm informing that the item is being retendered due to your withdrawal and asked if your firm is willing to supply at the quoted rate till the next bid is finalised. It was further informed that failure to agree to above shall lead to your firm being Blacklisted/Debarred from participating in any future tenders with AIIMS New Delhi for 02 years.
4. If no reply is received within 48 hours, it will be presumed that you have no explanation to offer, and further action as deemed appropriate by AIIMS will be taken without any further notice.

In response, your firm submitted the reply dt. 21.11.2025 stating that the rate was quoted by mistake. The reply was examined and found unsatisfactory, as quoting an incorrect rate cannot be accepted as a valid justification after bid finalization given that there were two opportunities for price bids, second one being RA.

Whereas, the withdrawal of offer by your firm resulted in a serious shortage of a critically required drug, adversely impacting patient care services. Although a fresh bid has been floated, finalization will take time, and interim arrangements are neither optimal nor sustainable.

Whereas, as per directions of the Medical Superintendent, your firm was provided a final opportunity vide email dated 18.12.2025, asking whether you were willing to supply the item at the quoted rate till finalization of the fresh bid, clearly stating that failure to respond would lead to debarment for two (02) years.

Despite granting the opportunity, no response was received from your firm.

Whereas, as per approval of the Medical Superintendent, your firm was called upon to show cause within 48 hours from the date of issuance of this notice as to why M/s Vinayak Manutrade Private Limited should not be debarred from participating in tenders/bids of AIIMS, New Delhi for a period of two (02) years for withdrawal of offer in GeM Bid No. GEM/2025/B/6481559 after being declared L-1 after completion of the Reverse Auction process. You were further informed in the SCN that you may submit your written reply along with supporting documentary evidences, if any and if you desire a personal hearing in the matter may specifically be requested in your reply.

Whereas it was clearly stated in the SCN that failure to respond within 48 hours from the date of issuance of this notice shall result in issuance of a final debarment order without any further notice, strictly in accordance with extant rules and guidelines though no response is received from your side within stipulated time.


Whereas, as per Rule 151 of GFR 2017 and Clause 5(c) of the *Guidelines on Debarment of Firms from Bidding* issued by the Department of Expenditure vide OM dated 02.11.2021, a bidder may be debarred for actions such as non-supply of material, abandonment of work, or failure to abide by bid commitments.

In the present case, your firm has:

- Withdrawn the offer after being declared L-1
- Failed to supply a critically required item
- Ignored the final opportunity for interim supply
- Caused disruption to patient care services and is liable to be debarred from bidding at AIIMS for two years.
- Did not respond the final SCN dated 02.02.2026, email dated 10.02.2026

Therefore, in view of the above facts and circumstances, the firm M/s Vinayak Manutrade Private Limited, Plot No. 87B RIICO Industrial Area, Jhotwara, Jaipur – 302012 has been debarred from participating in tenders/bids of AIIMS, New Delhi for a period of two (02) years from the date of issue of this order as per Clause 5(e) of the *Guidelines on Debarment of Firms from Bidding* issued by the Department of Expenditure vide OM dated 02.11.2021 for withdrawal of offer in GeM Bid No. GEM/2025/B/6481559 after being declared L-1 after completion of the Reverse Auction process.
