

A pre-bid meeting was held on 09.04.2026 at the Department of Radio-diagnosis, AIIMS New Delhi. Based on the queries raised and discussions held during the meeting, necessary amendments have been incorporated into the current EOI. These changes are final and binding on all participants.

In continuation to the uploaded specification for the empanelment of Diagnostic Centres for CT Scan and MRI Services, all prospective bidders are hereby notified of the following amendments and updates:

1. This amended EOI document supersedes and replaces in its entirety the previous EOI published on 30.03.2026. All previous ~~specification~~ and terms, and conditions are hereby treated as **null and void**. Bidders must strictly adhere to the updated specifications and terms provided in this revised specifications.
2. A comprehensive Checklist of Documents is enclosed. It is mandatory for every bidder to fill out this checklist and mention the relevant page numbers of the enclosed supporting documents. Failure to submit a complete checklist shall lead to the rejection of the bid without further evaluation.
3. Bidders are permitted to participate in both CT and MRI tenders, subject to meet the specific eligibility criteria for each. However, the bidder must submit separate sets of documents for each services. Documents must be attached and upload individually to ensure technical compliance for each modality.
4. All bids must be submitted exclusively through the CPP Portal only. No physical copies or email submissions will be entertained for the evaluation.



1. Introduction

AIIMS, New Delhi, invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from eligible Diagnostic Centres for providing MRI services for AIIMS New Delhi patients on outsourcing basis. This initiative aims to reduce waiting times for MRI appointments while giving patients the option to avail timely services from empanelled vendors at CGHS rates.

2. Scope of Work

The selected Diagnostic Centre will provide MRI services to OPD patients referred by AIIMS at CGHS Rates . The services will include:

- Conducting MRI scans as per AIIMS-approved protocols.
- Ensuring quality and timely delivery of reports within 48 hours of completion of the scan.
- Facilitating patient convenience and maintaining confidentiality of patient data.
- The waiting time for AIIMS patients should be minimum, and appointments shall be provided within a maximum period of four days from the date of referral.
- Payments for these MRI scans will be reimbursed by AIIMS to these empaneled Diagnostics Centers at CGHS rates. Patients shall make all payments at AIIMS New Delhi and shall in no way will be involved with the empaneled vendor for any financial transactions.
- The vendor will submit the bills for the previous month by the 7th of a month and AIIMS will process the payment after verification within 3 weeks.
- AIIMS in collaboration with the vendor will devise a mechanism to give the appointments to the patients at the empaneled centre via the HIS / other digital solution at AIIMS
- No extra charge will be levied by the centre for sedating the patient if clinically indicated.
- Beside routine MRI scans, services for specialized MRI scans e.g. MRI Spectro, MRCP, MRI Angio etc. may be required as per necessity.
- The Imaging centre has to provide CD of the MRI scan besides films to the patient. If any special software required for retrieving the data from CD, the software should be shared with this hospital. In addition, the imaging centre also has to share the scan on AIIMS PACS via network. AIIMS will share the details to access its PACS via web. Films provided shall be of standard size and medical-grade quality suitable for diagnostic purposes.
- Pre-fixed number of poor patients to be accommodated on non-chargeable basis. This will be 10% of the total business from AIIMS from the previous month. This will be on cumulative basis. Accordingly, the vendor shall raise monthly invoices after deduction of 10% amount on free patients (i.e. the bill shall be revised to 90% of the total monthly amount).

3. Eligibility Criteria

4. Submission Requirements

5. Terms and Conditions

AIIMS reserves the right to extend the empanelment further as well depending upon its needs based on mutual consent and approval of Competent Authority.
2. Diagnostic Centres must follow AIIMS-approved MRI protocols and standards.
3. AIIMS, New Delhi, reserves the right to inspect the diagnostic facility before empanelment and during the validity of the contract.
4. AIIMS reserves the right to terminate the empanelment in case of non-compliance with terms.
5. Diagnostic Centres must maintain the confidentiality of all patient data and submit an undertaking to this effect.
6. The termination of contract can be done by giving 1 month notice
7. Minor deviations in the above eligibility criteria may be accepted by the competent authority.
8. The vendor will not be allowed to display or use the name of AIIMS in any of their advertisements, boards or report letterheads
9. At the time of issue of LOI, the vendor will need to deposit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) of INR 3 lacs (Three lacs only) with a validity of 33 months. This amount maybe revised to a higher amount after the 6 months pilot period but shall not be higher than 3% of the average expected annual business for the empaneled center. Submission of the required PBG shall be a mandatory requirement at all times during the empanelment, failing which the empanelment of the said center shall automatically be deemed to be cancelled.
10. This empanelment will not be exclusive, if more than 1 Centres are eligible, they will also be empaneled on the same terms and conditions. AIIMS will retain the right for subsequent empanelment also in future if the need arises.

12. Any change or replacement of MRI equipment shall be duly intimated to the Competent Authority of AIIMS, New Delhi, and must strictly comply with the prescribed technical specifications.

14. Any complaint related to scan quality, reporting, or service delivery shall be reviewed by an internal committee headed by the Head of Department, Radiodiagnosis, AIIMS, New Delhi. In case of substantiated deficiencies, two warnings shall be issued; continued non-compliance will lead to termination of the contract and/or debarment of the bidder from future participation in tenders, as deemed appropriate by the Competent Authority.
15. AIIMS shall not be held responsible for any adverse incident if any, occurring to the patient during the procedure at the empaneled diagnostic centre. In such cases, the management of the adverse incident will be the responsibility of the empaneled centre.
