Subject: Urgent Procurement of Projection Lamp Bulb for Non-Functional Humphrey Visual Field Analyser

Respected Ma'am,

This is to bring to your kind notice that the Humphrey Visual Field Analyser (Carl Zeiss) installed in the perimetry lab (room no.80) has become non-functional due to the exhaustion/non-availability of the projection lamp bulb.

The requirement for the bulbs had already been submitted to the Surgical Store well in advance, and multiple reminders have subsequently been issued (reminder letter attached). However, despite repeated written as well as verbal follow-up, the required consumable item has still not been provided.

A few days ago, the last working bulb fused, rendering the machine non-functional and leading to disruption of routine glaucoma diagnostic services, thereby adversely affecting patient care.

In view of the critical importance of this equipment for patient care services, it is requested that the matter may kindly receive your urgent attention and that the procurement process for the required bulb from Carl Zeiss be expedited at the earliest.
