## AIIMS STATEMENT ON THE DAILY NEWS AND ANALYSIS (DNA) ARTICLE TITLED "NO SALARIES FOR ATLEAST 10,000 AIIMS EMPLOYEES" DATED JANUARY 18 2017

The article published in the Daily News and Analysis (DNA) titled "No Salaries for atleast 10,000 AIIMS Employees" dated January 18, 2017 suffers from factual inaccuracies and is misleading.

The Guidelines for Pay Revision for the Employees of Autonomous Organizations funded by Central Government were issued by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance Government of India on 13/1/2017. The Guidelines were adopted by AIIMS on 17/1/2017. AIIMS has sought options from Officers/Employees on or before 17/4/2017 so that the fixation of pay of officers/employees of the Institute may be done in a time bound manner.

The PAs/ PSs of AIIMS have been seeking pay parity under the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission with Central Stenographers Secretariat Service. The Government view hitherto has been that such pay parity between the officials of Central Stenographers Secretariat Service (CSSS) and PAs/ PSs of Autonomous Organizations is not possible as the recruitment of CSSS is on All India basis through SSC as compared to recruitments in Autonomous Organizations. The matter is sub-judice in the High Court of Delhi.

The AIIMS administration has recommended the revisions in faculty pay scales and allowances on the lines of the recommendations of the 7<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare following discussions with FAIMS. The FAIMS nor any individual faculty member has raised any pending issues of fixation of pay scales of 200 faculty members with AIIMS administration. There are regular consultations between FAIMS and AIIMS Administration and outstanding issues are resolved amicably.
